Workshop agenda: This full-day workshop will include regulatory updates on the Municipal Regional Permit and a panel presentation on implementing stormwater requirements at local new and redevelopment projects. There will be two tracks in the afternoon session. One track will offer an introduction to hydromodification management requirements and the Bay Area Hydrology Model. The other track will offer advanced training on low impact development topics including rainwater harvesting, green roofs, soil specifications, and retrofitting impervious areas with landscaping.
