- No leaf removal program other than routine street sweeping.
- This figure is a combined figure that includes the weight of the material collected from street sweeping PLUS the leaves collected by our autumn leaf pushing and pickup program. Since all of the material (both street sweeping and debris and leaves gathered by leaf pusher trucks) is combined and hauled to the landfill in garbage compactor trucks, there is no way to provide a separate figure for leaf removal.

- Los Altos Hills does not quantify street sweeping data.
- Total and average does not include 11,404 tons collected and 81,436 miles swept by the City of San Jose
